



PLAYER/ENTRY/EXIT INSTRUCTIONS 2020-2021

- Mask MUST be worn by ALL persons in the building when not on the ice surface. (City of Hamilton and Public Health)
- Arrive 15 mins prior to sessions, exit 10 mins after session. (City of Hamilton and Public Health)
- Arena Entrance/Exit-as demarcated by City of Hamilton separate/entrance/exits
- Maintain social distancing outside while you wait. (City of Hamilton and Public Health)
- PARTICPANTS ENTER AFTER ALL PREVIOUS PARTICPANTS LEAVE INDICATED BY CITY STAFF (DOORS WILL BE LOCKED UNTIL OPENED BY CITY)
- CITY OF HAMILTON WILL SIGN IN PLAYER AND PARENT
- TEAM COACH/TRAINER/TEAM PARENT REPRESENTATIVE will meet players to perform OHF COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire (City of Hamilton and Public Health/OHF)
- OHF/PHU COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire performed and recorded at each ice-time upon entrance of facility for contract tracing.
- ONCE SCREENED PLAYERS MAY ENTER AND PROCEED TO RINK SIDE
- 1 Guardian to enter with player currently (City of Hamilton and Public Health requirement)
- NO ADDITIONAL SPECTATORS currently permitted (City of Hamilton and Public Health)
- NO USE OF DRESSING ROOMS, (City of Hamilton and Public Health)-Come partially or fully dressed, skates will be put on rink side. Hockey bags are permitted into facility
- NO OUTSIDE food, or drink permitted. WATER BOTTLES PERMITTED FOR SPORT. (City of Hamilton and Public Health)
- No access to upstairs viewing at Harry Howell-is closed (City of Hamilton and Public Health)
- Late participants may not be able to join a session in progress as screening protocols will dictate
- All other OMHA hockey rules apply, mouth guards and certified equipment
