THE CITY OF HAMILTON ADVISE THE FOLLOWING AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT FOR ALL ICE USER GROUPS AND PARTICIPANTS FOLLOWING THE FIRST FEW WEEKS OF HOCKEY OPERATIONS:

ENTRY GUIDELINES INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR OR PRACTICES

What is not acceptable:

- Disregarding directions of staff
- Falsely signing in as a parent/guardian
- Spectators sitting in closed sections

DRESSING ROOMS

Dressing rooms are open. Masks must be worn at all times and please try to maintain social distancing.

ARENA CAPCITY LIMITS

The City of Hamilton will have capacity limits set for each of the arena's in the city. Although the City of Hamilton is not limiting the number of spectators per family please be aware that once capacity limits for the arena are reached you could be denied entry. Please be mindful of all of our hockey families when bring spectators to the arena.

OUT OF TOWN GUESTS

Please ensure that out of town visitors and leagues are aware of our operational protocols during this time. Masks must be worn at all times. Due to City of Hamilton facility capacity limitations on the persons attending, once capacity limits for the arena are reached you could be denied entry.

FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT WITH THE CITY OF HAMILTON NOT ALLOWING ADMISSION AND PARTICIPATION AND COULD JEOPRDIZE THE FHA'S ICE PROGRAMMING PACKAGE.
